- Qualifications:**
- A. A degree in Chemical Engineering or Sugar Technology or Sugar Engineering from a recognised institution or an equivalent qualification from a recognised institution acceptable to the Board.
- B. Candidates should:
- (i) be computer literate;
 - (ii) possess sound organisational ability and supervisory skills; and
 - (iii) possess good communication, interpersonal and problem-solving skills.

For the first intake, by appointment of the Sugar Technologist on the permanent and pensionable establishment of the former Cane Planters and Millers Arbitration and Control Board in line with the Memorandum of Understanding dated 27 March 2012.

- Role and Responsibilities:** To be responsible to the Director, Control and Arbitration Department for administrative and technical duties of the Department and to represent management, as and when required.

- Duties:**
1. To carry out, under the supervision of the Director, Control and Arbitration Department, the following: -
 - (i) assessment of sugar and sugar cane by-products and to prepare reports for the Authority, planters and other institutions; and
 - (ii) research work in various methods of cane payment, cane analysis and in any related areas.
 2. To carry out investigations concerning the delimitation of factory areas and their sub-regions.
 3. To exercise general control over the Department's laboratories.

4. To be responsible for:
 - (i) the testing, verifying and control of machines and peripherals used for the weighing of cane, sugar and related products; and
 - (ii) the maintenance of computer software linked to the cane payment system.
5. To liaise between the cane planting community and deal with disputes between planters and millers.
6. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
7. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Sugar Technologist/Senior Sugar Technologist in the roles ascribed to him.
